Some of the not as exciting, but much needed improvements that are essential in our operation are new HVAC equipment, computer software that helps operate the irrigation system more effectively, 2 new Defibrillators (that hopefully we don't have to use again like we did this summer), and the list goes on. Our goal is to continue to improve on what we have and make sure we are able to hire and retain staff that makes all of this possible.

***This year if you pay by January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022 you will receive 2 Guest Passes if you purchase a Single Membership, or 4 Guest Passes if you purchase a Couples Membership. The passes will apply to the Links course only if you purchase a Links Membership. But apply to either course if you purchase an Old Course membership.*** We are continuing with the \$5 discount on regular 18 hole green fees for any guest playing with a member. It does not apply to any already discounted rounds like the Senior rates. This fee applies anytime Monday through Friday and Weekends after 1pm.
