New Richmond Golf Club 2024 Co-Ed League Information

When: Every other Friday from May 17th – August 23rd Friday, September 6th – 9 Hole League Championship

Format:

Net Best Ball (6/28 & 8/23) Net 2-Person Scramble (5/17 and 7/12) Net 2-Person Scrumble (5/31 and 7/26) Chapman (6/14 and 8/9)

9-hole **Net Best Ball**

- will use 100% of your current handicap.
- you will count the one best net score per hole of the two golfer's scores.

9-hole **Net Scramble** (best shot taken for each shot)

• you will use 20% of the team's total handicap.

9-hole **Net Scrumble** (take best tee shot and play your own ball from there)

- you will use 80% of each Person's Handicap
- you will count the **one best net score** per hole of the two golfer's scores 9-hole **Chapman** (both tee off, switch balls then choose the best 2nd shot and alternate in from there until holed out)
 - you will use 25% of your team's total handicap

Points will be awarded each night based on where your score placed in relationship to the other participants. If we end up with 25 teams, then the first place team each night will receive 25 points and the last place team would receive 1 point with each team in between receiving the amount of points that their finish dictates.

The top 10 – 14 (depending on number of entries) teams from each half of the season will play in the 9-Hole League Championship on Friday, September 6^{th} . The top 10 – 14 teams in the second half that <u>have not</u> already qualified for the championship will be deemed the qualifiers from the second half

Entry Fee

\$100 per team includes handicap fee and prizes for the season. You may deduct \$30 per player that has already paid their handicap fee through the New Richmond Golf Club. **Please turn your application in before May 15th.**

Eligibility

- □ Each player will use their WSGA handicap, if you have not yet established a WSGA handicap you will have to play with a temporary handicap assigned by the pro shop until you establish an official handicap. Please be certain to enter all of your non-league scores in the handicap computer. League scores will be posted to the handicap computer automatically. The sooner you establish an official handicap the better off you will be.
- □ Teams will consist of 1 Male Golfer and 1 Female Golfer. This can also be partners or mother/son or father/daughter, grandfather/granddaughter etc.

Schedule - All rounds to be played at the "Old Course"

Rain Outs

A rain out policy is in effect for those times scheduled after Noon on League Fridays. If your scheduled tee time, Noon or later, is rained out you will have through the following Friday to play your round. League will be cancelled if more than 50% of the teams which had tee times scheduled after Noon are unable to play due to rain.

Scoring

Ties will not be broken during the regular season, but they will be broken by a scorecard playoff in the championship. If two teams tie for the top spot in a given week during the regular season, we will award first place points to both teams. If two teams qualify in a tie for the final spot of either half season they will both qualify for the championship. If you are absent, you will be awarded zero points for that week. The total points that your team earns per half season will be comprised of your 3 best point totals from the 4 weeks of play per half season. This means that – yes, you can throw out 1 score per half season.

Championship Qualifying

The season will be broken up into two halves. The first half will be from May 17th – June 28th and the second half will run from July 12th – August 23rd. The championship will be held on Friday, September 6th and will be **contested over 9 holes**.

There will be a prize payout for the top 4 teams in each half season. If you have already secured a spot in the championship you may still win prizes in the second half of the season, but you will not be eligible for another qualifying spot. The top 10 - 14 teams with the most points in the first half of the season will qualify for the championship. The top 10 - 14 teams in the second half that <u>have not</u> already qualified for the championship will be deemed the qualifiers from the second half.

Substitutes

If your partner can't make it on a given night, you can still play by yourself or bring a substitute of the same gender as your partner, but your substitute cannot be an active participant of another Co-Ed League team. All substitute players must have a current WSGA handicap. No substitute teams will be allowed. You must have one representative from your original team.

Pay Out

All payouts will be in the form of Pro Shop Credits from the New Richmond Golf Club. These winnings may only be used towards the purchase of merchandise from the Pro Shop. They cannot be used towards greens fees, range fees, cart fees, or bar purchases.

Each week we will have optional hole event games for both Men and Women at a cost of \$5.00 per person.
